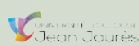

PUBLIC SELECTION BASED ON QUALIFICATIONS AND MOTIVATION LETTER FOR 20 POSITIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL IN ANTHROPOLOGY AND ETHNOGRAPHY (SARDINIA - ITALY)

Art. 1 – Purpose of the call

A public selection based on qualifications and a motivation letter is hereby announced for 20 places for participation in the International Summer School in Anthropology and Ethnography (ISSAE) organized by the Istituto Superiore Regionale Etnografico.

Art. 2 – General Information

The second edition of the Summer School will take place in Isili, in the province of Cagliari (Italy), from 7 to 13 September 2026. The ISSAE training activities will focus on the following themes and issues:

1. Anthropology and ethnography of heritage, environment, and local craft production;
2. Anthropology and ethnography of mobility and regional and inter-regional connections;
3. Anthropology and ethnography of expert communities and the social networks associated with them;
4. Anthropology and ethnography of local development policies within the framework of global sustainability policies.

Activities will be conducted in Italian and English. During the first three days, the morning sessions will be devoted to seminars, lectures, and discussions, while the afternoons and evenings will include workshops and fieldwork exercises. The fourth day will be dedicated to a territorial visit (Samugheo, Mogoro, Siddi). During the last two days, participants will focus exclusively on field research. At the end of the Summer School, the first results of the research activities (reports, video interviews, etc.) will be presented in a public presentation.

During this edition, several collaborations will be established with local cultural institutions, including:

- MARATE – Museum of Copper and Textile, Isili
- MURATS – Regional Museum of Sardinian Textile Art, Samugheo
- Casa Steri – Museum of Sardinian Agri-Food Traditions, Siddi

Attendance at the ISSAE Summer School may qualify for the recognition of ECTS credits, according to the provisions of individual universities and based on specific agreements with the participants' home institutions within the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).



Attendance at the Summer School activities is mandatory for registered participants (excluding auditors).

All registered participants, including auditors who attend the activities, will receive a certificate of participation and attendance.

The Summer School is organized with the collaboration and patronage of national and international partners.

Art. 3 – Costs and Expenses

ISRE will cover:

- Accommodation in Isili for 7 nights (check-in: 6 September 2026, check-out: 13 September 2026);
- One meal per day (lunch or dinner);
- Travel expenses within the territory (10 September) and museum entrance fees included in the program.

The following expenses remain the responsibility of the participant:

- The participation contribution of €250.00 referred to in Art. 7;
- Travel expenses to Isili, where the Summer School will take place;
- The second daily meal (lunch or dinner);
- Accommodation expenses beyond the 7th night.



Art. 4 – Admission Requirements

- a) ISSAE is open to Master's students, postgraduate specialization students, PhD students, graduates in demo-ethno-anthropology and other fields within the humanities, as well as professionals involved in cultural activities such as the protection, safeguarding, and promotion of cultural heritage.
- b) The ISSAE will be activated with a minimum of 10 registered participants and can admit a maximum of 20 participants. Up to 10 auditors may also be admitted.
- c) All participants, including auditors, must complete the application form, specifying the type of participation (participant or auditor). Both options may be indicated. If no preference is specified, the application will automatically be considered for a participant position.

The suitability of academic qualifications obtained abroad will be assessed by the Selection Committee in accordance with current Italian regulations and the regulations of the country where the studies were completed.

All 20 participants must have knowledge of English (level B2). For international participants, knowledge of Italian (level B1) is desirable.

Art. 5 – Evaluation Criteria for Admission

To apply for ISSAE, applicants must complete the application form and attach the following documents in PDF format:

- CV (curriculum vitae et studiorum) in Italian or English, duly signed;
- Motivation letter in Italian or English (maximum 800 words), duly signed;
- Identity document.

The maximum score is 100 points, with a maximum of 40 points for qualifications and a maximum of 60 points for the motivation letter. Qualifications will be evaluated internally by the Istituto Superiore Regionale Etnografico della Sardegna according to the following scheme:

* Degree, specialization, PhD, or other qualification (including thesis or curriculum) in the SDEA-01/A Demo-Ethno-Anthropological Disciplines sector.

** For each additional qualification (Master's degree level I or II, degree, advanced training school): 4 points if relevant to SDEA-01/A; 2 points if not relevant. Research grants, fellowships, Summer School certificates, and work experience will be considered in relation to the motivation letter.

After the qualification assessment, the Procedure Manager will transmit the results to the Selection Committee responsible for evaluating the motivation letters.

The Committee will assign scores to the motivation letters based on the coherence, relevance, and consistency of the applicant's academic, research, and professional background with the educational and scientific objectives of the Summer School.

In the event of a tie, preference will be given to the younger candidate.

Among the eligible candidates, 10 places will be reserved for students from partner institutions, assigning one place per partner institution, according to the ranking list until the reserved places are filled.

If an insufficient number of applications is received from partner institutions, the remaining places will be redistributed among the other candidates.

Candidates must obtain at least 60 points to be included in the ranking list for the 20 available places.

The Selection Committee is appointed by decision of the Director General. The Committee will draw up a ranking list based on the total score obtained from the evaluation of qualifications and the motivation letter. The Director General of ISRE will approve the final ranking list, which will be published at: <https://isresardegna.portaleservizipa.it/index.php/ente/avvisi> and on the **ISRE website**.

Art. 6 – Application Procedure and Deadline

The application for participation, duly dated and signed, must be submitted in plain paper using the form attached to this notice, by 23:59 on 9/04/2026 by email to: isresardegna@pec.it. The subject line must contain: "SURNAME – Application ISSAE 2026".

The application must include:

1. Application form including self-certification of qualifications;
2. Signed European-format CV;
3. Signed motivation letter;
4. Copy of an identity document¹.



The submission date will be determined by the email sending date.

No additions or modifications to submitted applications are allowed. If necessary, a new complete application must be submitted before the deadline. In the case of multiple submissions, the last one received will be considered valid. Unsigned applications will be declared inadmissible and excluded. In accordance with applicable regulations on self-certification, the Institute will carry out appropriate checks on the accuracy of declarations.

By submitting the application, the candidate accepts all provisions of this call.

Art. 7 – Finalization of Enrollment

Admitted candidates must complete enrollment no later than 5/07/2026 by paying the participation contribution of €250.00 via a PagoPA notice generated and sent by the Institute; signing a liability waiver declaration provided by the Institute.

Failure to pay the contribution will result in automatic exclusion.

Non-payment will be considered as a withdrawal, and the place will be assigned to the next eligible candidate in the ranking list.

Art. 8 – Auditors

Participation as an auditor is permitted. The number of auditors may not exceed 50% of registered students. Applicants must indicate their interest in participating as auditors when submitting their application. Auditors: are not required to attend all activities; are not required to participate in the field research stage; are not required to produce the final project work. All expenses (meals, accommodation, travel, museum tickets) are entirely the responsibility of the auditor. Auditors will receive a certificate of attendance for the activities they attended.

Art. 9 – Publication and Communications

Program

The International Summer School in Anthropology and Ethnography is designed to be itinerant. Theme: Skilled Knowledge, Mobility, and Local Communities

In its second edition, the ISSAE school meets Isili, a community in the Sarcidano area with a long tradition of craftsmanship in weaving and copperworking, which has historically linked these skills to the ability to create extensive exchange networks, spreading them along the island's communication routes. The Isili community has demonstrated its ability to represent itself through two important ethnographic museums: the Museum of Traditional Weaving and the MARATE (Museum of Copper and Textile Art).

The training activities planned in Isili will take into account the complex cultural and social reality of the community, which is characterized by important aspects of entrepreneurial and cultural dynamism linked to the presence of a significant economic and productive fabric compared to other areas of the island, and important previous work on the material and symbolic heritage of craftsmanship, as well as on local memory, as evidenced by the museums and the cultural and educational tradition of the town (public library, reading centers, schools, cultural associations).

Isili and the entire Sarcidano area, however, are, like the whole island, subject to a decline in population and rural abandonment, which remains the underlying factor in every survey and every educational project on the locality in Southern Europe.

Taking this into account, ISSAE 2026's educational activities will focus on the following areas:

- Anthropology and ethnography of local heritage, environment, and craft production;
- Anthropology and ethnography of mobility and area and regional connections;
- Anthropology and ethnography of expert communities and their social networks;
- Anthropology and ethnography of local development policies in the context of global sustainability policies.

General Program

The second edition of ISSAE will last seven days, from September 7 to 13, and will take place in Isili. The first three days will begin with morning sessions dedicated to seminars, oral presentations, and debates, while the afternoon and evening will feature workshop activities and field exercises. The fourth day will be dedicated to a territorial visit (Samugheo, Mogoro, Siddi). On the last two days, participants will focus exclusively on field research. At the end of the Summer School, there will be a public round table discussion of the work (reports, photographs, videos, video interviews, etc.) produced by the participants.
